I've been reading a book entitled *The Seeking Heart: A Journey with Henry Nouwen*, and I never want it to end! It's been like good food to me. So, to make it last longer, I'll share what I'm learning in the Lenten services on Wednesdays in March at 6:30 p.m.

Here are some introductory comments selected from the book:

At the heart of the Christian story lies a threefold plot: All was created good and well; through our disobedience and folly we distorted this pristine setting; and God with persistent love seeks to bring about a full mending, healing and restoration....

The biblical story speaks not only of new heavens and earth as the grandest frame of this restoration, but also of humans receiving a new heart and mind. . . .[Henry Nouwen explains that God invites us] "to come and know that I [the Lord God] have come to give you a new heart and a new spirit."

But how do we understand all of this? Can we really be transformed? And what does it mean that we may receive a new heart and a new spirit?

For the next five Wednesday evenings, we'll talk about the transformation that occurs within and around us because of our encounters with Jesus Christ.

Writer's Corner...

We need God to survive a stormy world

We live in an increasingly stormy world. It seems like every day there is another event putting human lives in jeopardy. Here are just a few from recent days:

- During the weekend of Feb. 17-19 alone, 10 mass shootings across America killed 13 people and injured 46 more. We've had about 1.5 mass shootings (when four or more people killed or injured by a shooter or shooters) per day on average during 2023 in our country. They're so common we only hear on the news about the most egregious.
- 2. I can't remember a winter when millions who live in southern states faced loss of life and livelihood because of tornadoes every single week. In California, a year's worth of rain in a single storm causes floods and mud slides that destroy properties and take lives. The severity of weather seems to have reached levels like never before in our lifetimes.
- 3. Along the Turkey-Syria border, the death toll from multiple earthquakes and aftershocks is nearing 50,000 and still rising.
- 4. In Ohio a train derailment unleashes toxic chemicals upon a town, disrupting lives and causing health problems for weeks.
- 5. A dictator in Russia decides he wants to reconstruct the Soviet Union and puts the free world on the brink of World War 3.
- 6. Political division is rampant like never before in my lifetime, pitting Americans against Americans, friends against friends and even family against family. It seems like as a society we've forgotten the courtesies of civil discourse.

But the storm that scares me the most is the attack on Christianity in our country. All Christians are being lumped with the far right televangelists and others who espouse "traditional values" that are perceived by many to denigrate women, people of color and those with different orientations. This dynamic makes our

work to share the love of Jesus with our community and world more and more challenging.

The Lenten season gives us a structured opportunity to reflect on what God through Jesus life, death and resurrection accomplished to save us from our sinful selves. I pray that all of us will make a special effort during Lent to look introspectively at ourselves and to act with unbridled love to support our family, friends, neighbors and communities.

In all our interactions, let's keep in mind this question: "What would Jesus do?"
